

ERASMUS+ programme

- Over 300 agreements (188 partner universities);
- 115 European students have validated part of their degree course in 2017/2018 at UPPA
- 220 UPPA students have spent time in a EU country in 2017/2018

<u>UPPA's cross-border relations</u> <u>with Spain</u>

- 42 students received crossborder mobility grants;
- **41** students did **internships** in a firm or with a cross-border institution;
- 13 double degrees;
- 34 co-supervisions were funded;
- 80 university lecturers and researchers, and mobilized administrative staff.
