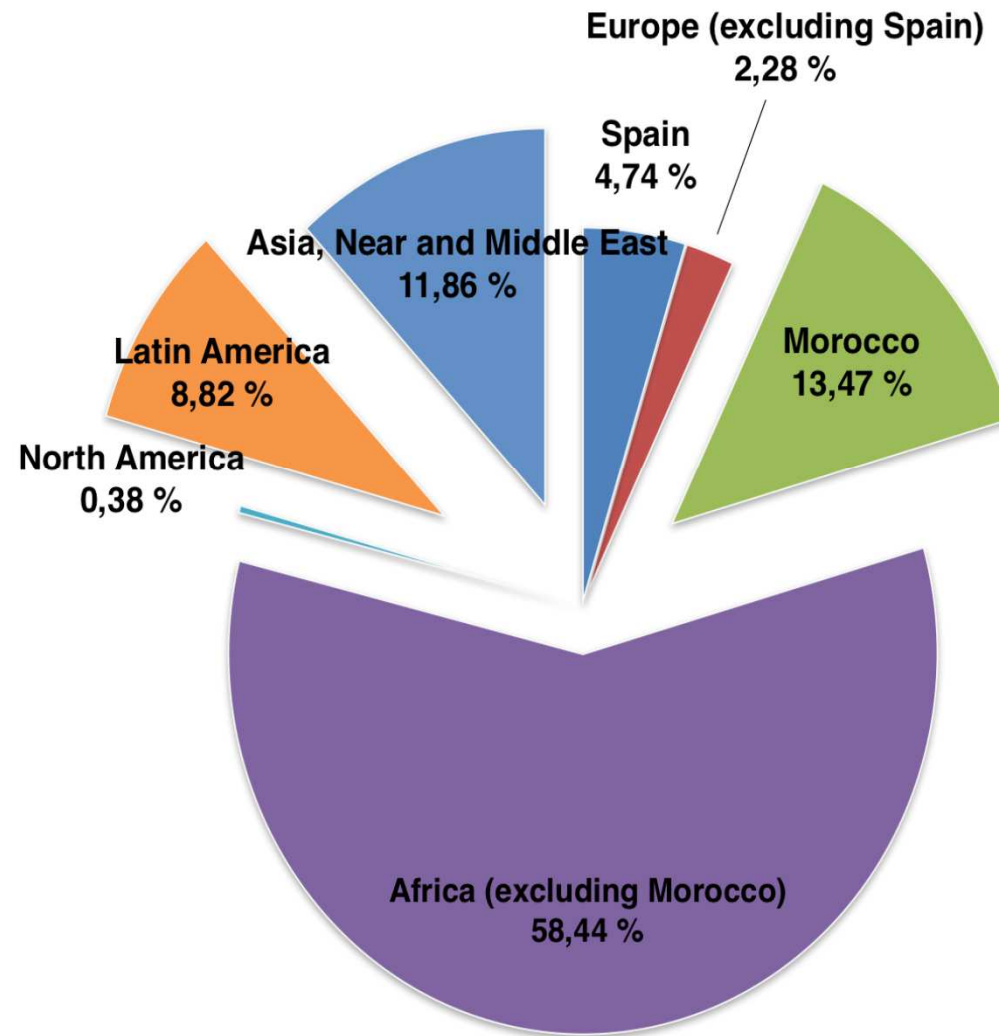

UPPA europeans relations

ERASMUS+ programme

- **Over 300** agreements (188 partner universities);
- **115** European students have validated part of their degree course in 2017/2018 at UPPA
- **220** UPPA students have spent time in a EU country in 2017/2018

UPPA's cross-border relations with Spain

- **42** students received **cross-border mobility grants**;
- **41** students did **internships** in a firm or with a cross-border institution;
- **13 double degrees**;
- **34 co-supervisions** were funded;
- **80** university lecturers and researchers, and mobilized administrative staff.
