J-PAC Programme (Japan Programme at Chiba)

- Academic programmes for undergraduate students from partner universities
- 1 year programme starting in October
or 1 semester programme starting in October or April
- Joint supervision by J-PAC supervisors and J-PAC coordinator

Programme	Eligibility	Purpose
International Liberal Arts Programme	For those who have already acquired some Japanese language skills and are interested in Japanese society and culture.	Deepen understanding of Japan for gaining new viewpoints on each native culture and society. Acquire ability to think about global problems from multiple perspectives in order to solve them irrespective of language barriers and different behavioral patterns.
Japanese Studies Programme	For those who specialize in Japanese Studies at their universities, and who wish to study about Japan in the Japanese language.	Using Japanese in the subjects of their interest to deepen knowledge of the language itself. To view Japan from many different perspectives through collaborative learning in a multicultural environment.

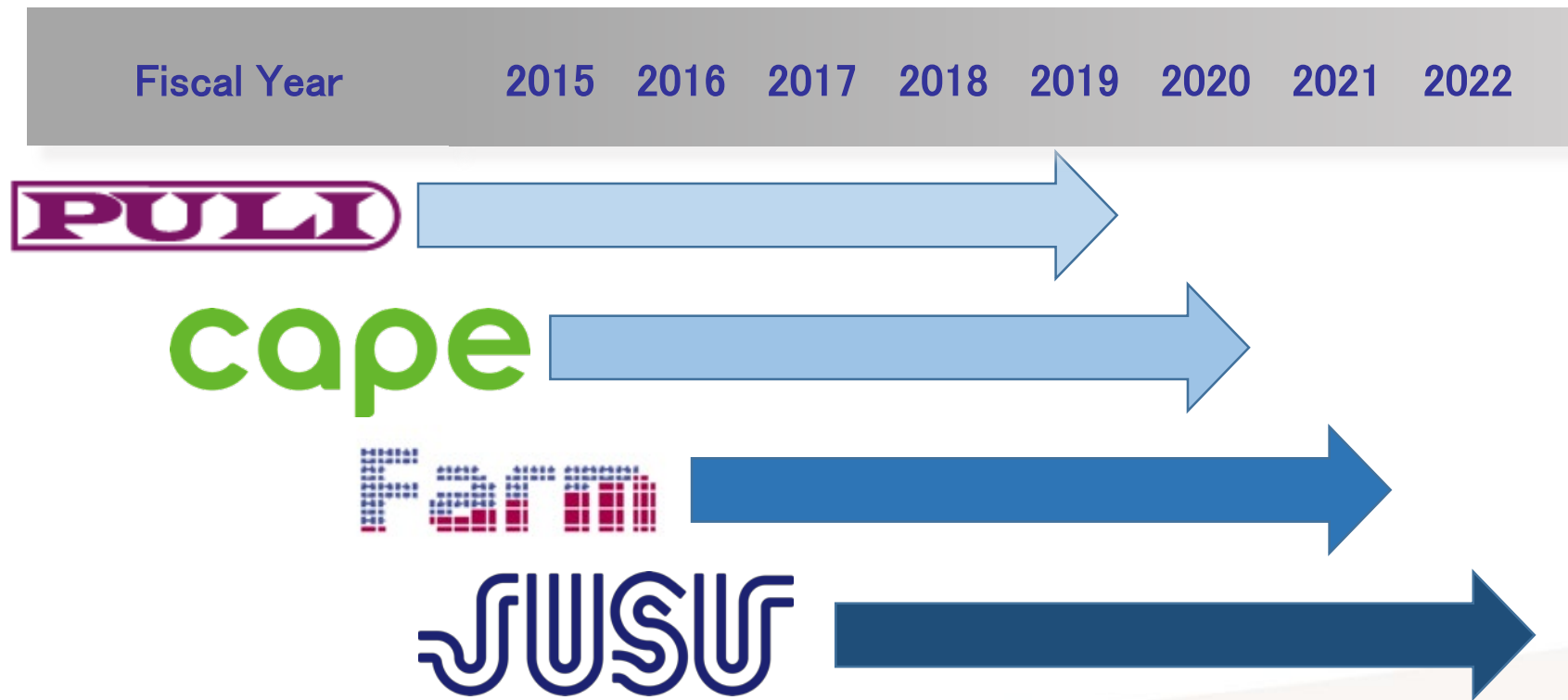
