#### **ESTABLISHING A FOCUS ON BILATERAL RELATIONSHIPS**

#### Why focus on UK-Japan collaboration?

- **Excellence in R&I:** Higher Education institutions in both countries are leaders in innovation, scientific discovery and technological advancement. Both countries produce high quality research at scale.
- > **Shared ambitions:** Investment in Research and Development is a priority for both the UK and Japanese governments in the long-term, and the UK and Japanese R&D sectors have specific strengths in complementary fields.
- > Quality of collaborations: Where Japan and the UK collaborate, the research is very high quality and impact.
- > Scope to do more: UK-Japan collaboration has grown significantly—but mobility and exchange remains relatively low

### PATTERNS OF COLLABORATION (1)

#### **Summary of emerging messages**

- Japanese researchers are increasingly collaborating with counterparts from overseas institutions. Their primary international partners are the US, China, Germany, the UK and France.
- UK-Japanese joint research output has been growing since 2010. The UK is now Japan's 4<sup>th</sup> most popular partner – and the impact is high.
- More Japanese researchers engage in mobility and exchange **programmes every year** – and more international researchers engage in mobility and exchange programmes in Japan every year.
- Japanese staff and students are relatively under-represented in the UK –and there is scope for more reciprocal mobility. Exchange opportunities are available in various forms, but engagement is limited.
